In the month of November, we will have a Commemoration of our Franciscan deceased. We have our own Dorothy Burroughs, who was one of our shut-ins. She passed last February, one month short of being professed for 50 years. Kay and I were the last of our fraternity to see her the day before she died. And her last request of us was, "Did you bring Communion?" For her, Eucharist was the source and summit of her life. Dorothy was a sweetheart and a saint.

Eucharist originates from the Greek word *eucharista*, meaning thanksgiving. Holy Family Parish will be hosting our own Cardinal Cupich at 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday, November 6th. He will be speaking about the Eucharistic Revival, which is a U.S. Bishops' 3-year initiative; we are currently into the second year of this event. So, I am urging you all to attend.

Our liturgy for the month of November is the LOTH; please remember to bring your Christian Prayer Book.

Our Franciscan Outreach project for the month of November will be to bring the donations that you signed up for in October to fill the three Thanksgiving baskets for the Palatine Township needy.

Lastly, I want to thank you for all your awesome financial assistance to Feed My Starving Children every month. This month we were able to match the donation of \$53 and donate \$106, which feeds one child for a year, easing their worries about food insecurity. The staff at FMSC is very thankful for your help.

Recently, Patti and I were able to meet the CEO of FMSC, Mark Crea. Mark stated that FMSC is Christ centered. Their goal is to provide 400 million meals a year. Currently they have a 150 million gap between their promise and what they have provided. The mantra for the staff of FMSC is:

For the abandoned, food is the core of it all. FOOD IS THE FOUNDATION...
"Taste and See the Goodness of the Lord."

This food allows children to go from survival to hope. Our next FMSC date will be on Wednesday, December 18th, 2:00-3:45 p.m.
